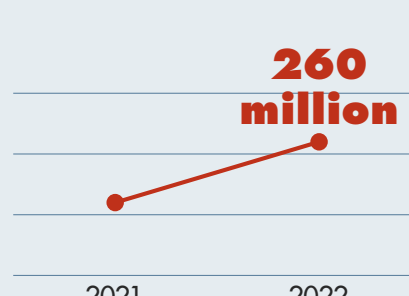


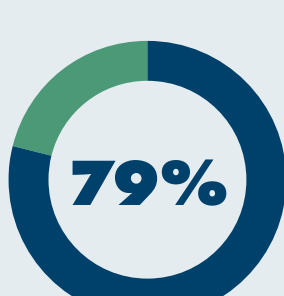


PROTECT YOUR PACKAGES WITH UPS® DELIVERY CONFIRMATION OPTIONS

UPS DELIVERY CONFIRMATION OPTIONS

1 UPS ADULT SIGNATURE REQUIRED

WHAT: The driver will get the signature or electronic acknowledgement of receipt from an adult recipient.

WHEN: If your shipment contains age-restricted content such as alcohol or firearms.

Pro Tip
View the signature on your ups.com account or another online UPS shipping tool.



Pro Tip
The person listed on the package doesn't have to be the one who signs for it.

2 UPS SIGNATURE REQUIRED

WHAT: UPS won't deliver the shipment without a signature or electronic acknowledgement of receipt.

WHEN: For high-value shipments and other important packages.

Pro Tip
The person listed on the package doesn't have to be the one who signs for it.

3 PROOF OF DELIVERY

WHAT: UPS will send a confirmation email or text once the package is delivered.

WHEN: For domestic shipments — even if a signature isn't required.

Pro Tip
The confirmation includes time of delivery, delivery address, and the name and signature of the recipient.



Pro Tip
While this option is more convenient for customers, consider shipping insurance to further protect your packages.

4 NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED (STANDARD SERVICE)

WHAT: You can track a package online and request an email or text notification when it's delivered.

WHEN: For packages that don't require a signature.

Always give your customers shipment tracking information and delivery details — especially if a signature is required.
